- 4. That the applicant meet with ANC 3-C on an annual basis to present needed information on the impact of traffic, and to provide an opportunity to present and discuss issues impacting on the neighborhood, with the understanding that the purpose of such an annual meeting is to seek resolution of identified problems.
- 5. This special exception shall be for approximately 8 years -- that is, to be up for renewal (if renewal is desired) at the time when the current special exception for the current school will have expired.

## V1. The following resolution was adopted by unanimous voice vote:

WHEREAS: Local residents are concerned about traffic problems in the immediate vicinity of the intersection of Porter Street and Connecticut Avenue, N.W. as well as Klingle Road and the environmental degradation of Klingle Valley;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That ANC 3-C urges the Department of Public Works to expeditiously complete its reassessment; respond to citizen concerns about congestion on Porter Street and Connecticut Avenue, Klingle Road, and the environmental degradation of Klingle Valley; provide the results of its ongoing traffic study; and make its recommendations about the project so that ANC 3-C may act on this matter at its meeting on February 27th, 1995.
